POSITION SUMMARY

Works with project teams and partners to establish and implement dual credit pathways for high school youth to earn college credit while completing graduation goals. Position works to implement a culturally responsive education program that advances college and career readiness for Alaska Native and American Indian Students in Juneau and other Southeast Alaska Communities in collaboration with Juneau, Angoon and Klukwan/Haines Youth Educational Specialists.

Works to develop teaching lessons and provide lead instruction focusing on dual credit and sponsored courses based on traditional values to serve middle school and high school youth in collaboration with educators. Provides development of the draft curriculum lessons, field testing, revision and final completion of units. Position additionally works with partner teachers on curriculum development and teacher training opportunities. This includes facilitating teacher training workshops in collaboration with project staff and educators.

Works with educators to connect cultural knowledge and/or heritage language to core content in curriculum.

Develops and coordinates a career and cultural Service Learning and Mentorship Program to serve Alaska Native youth ages 14 to 18.

Youth Specialist provides instruction and academic support to youth.

Youth Specialist plans coursework and workshops in addition to working with project team to convene parent, family and elder youth gatherings on a regular basis within the community providing family/student resources, providing language and cultural enrichment activities with the goal of establishing Youth Councils at both the Middle and High School grade levels.

Youth Specialist attends with youth the annual student celebration gathering which will involve regularly scheduled planning and preparatory activities with youth.

Specialist works with project staff to facilitate Middle and High School Summer Youth Academies in Juneau, Alaska or other locations to be determined.

Work with staff and elders to meet project objectives/goals.

QUALIFICATIONS: Requires experience teaching at a secondary level and ability to provide lead instruction in early college pathways courses. Demonstrated experience developing educational teaching lessons for youth; experience providing youth instruction/training and requires extensive teaching experience; prefer experience supporting youth development and knowledge of Southeast Alaska communities, language, culture, people and demonstrated experience working with the community.

Requires a degree in Education or a related field; and/or requires a background in anthropology, education, or related field with teaching experience in Tlingit culture and/or language at the middle, secondary or college level; knowledge of Southeast Alaska cultures; the ability to inspire.
