



Goldbelt Heritage Foundation Tuition Waiver for UAS Fall 2020

Goldbelt Heritage Foundation is excited to announce that a tuition waiver can be provided to the following courses as a part of our Alaska Native learning pathways for Indigenous students between the ages of 14-24.

Students are limited to apply the tuition waiver to two courses to receive funding.

*Please note that you are ultimately responsible for registering for your own courses and scheduling academic advising appointments. Students that are seeking dual enrollment in high school will need to make an academic advisor appointment with UAS, and submit a secondary student agreement form. Forms can be found at <https://www.uas.alaska.edu/forms/>. Goldbelt Heritage Foundation staff can provide assistance as needed with the application process. Eligibility:

- Alaska Native students ages 14 – 24.
- Must be enrolled in at least one of the following listed University of Alaska Southeast courses.
- Students under the age of 18 will need to complete a Secondary Parental Agreement Form and make a UAS advisor appointment.
- Must currently reside in Alaska.

Deadline:

- The deadline to receive the tuition waiver is August 28th on the first initial day of the Fall 2020 semester.
- A completed application of Education Record Information Release, Proof of Registration, and Indigenous Studies Tuition Waiver Application forms need to be submitted to Sandra Demmert at sandra.demmert@goldbelt.com by the first day of instruction August 28th.
